

LOW-FLOW FAUCETS

One of the best ways to conserve water and energy is to purchase your new Sani-Lav sink or wash-station with a low-flow faucet. The term “low flow” refers to faucets that use less water to accomplish the same tasks such as washing your hands. Compared to 2.0 GPM aerators, 0.5 GPM aerators reduce water flow by 77%.

A growing number of states, including California, Colorado, and Texas, have enacted low-flow legislation, and if you live in one of those states, you have no option other than buying low-flow faucets but no matter where you live you and your business will benefit from a low-flow faucet.

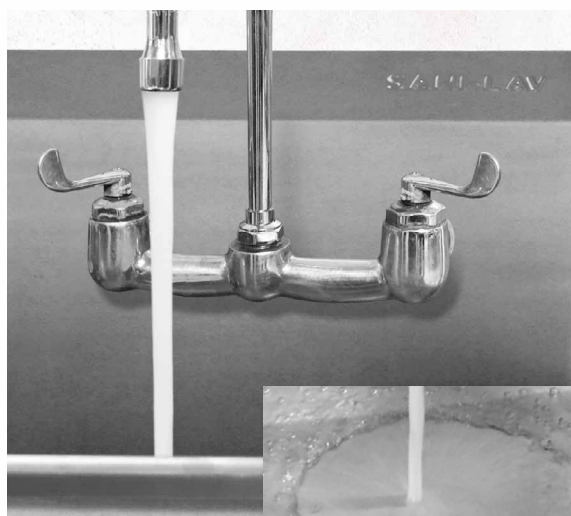
A few low-flow facts:

You'll conserve more water and money.

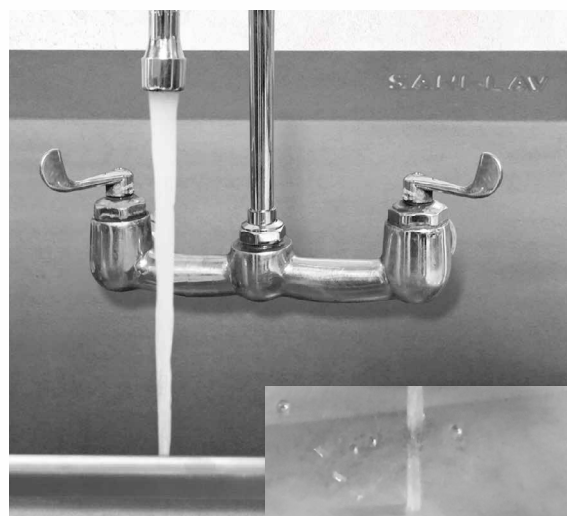
Purchasing our low-flow faucets will quickly pay for itself, and you may be surprised about the amount of water and energy you'll conserve.
